

CT Scan without IV or Oral Contrast Patient Preps

If your test is ordered without IV or Oral Contrast, your procedure will not take very long. You may be asked to change into a gown, depending on what part of your body we are scanning. You will be asked to fill out a history questionnaire that the front desk staff will give you when you check in. This will aid the Radiologist who reads your CT Scan.

The radiologist will interpret the exam and send the results to your physician's office.

If you have questions about your test, you can either ask your Doctor or call the department that will be doing your exam (770-535-3553) and the operator will transfer your call accordingly.
