

Electronic Medication References in MyChart

Opt to go paperless in NGHS Retail Pharmacies

To access electronic medication references (Monographs and Medication Guides):

1. Call the pharmacy:
 - Gainesville Pharmacy (770) 219-6337
 - Braselton Pharmacy (770) 848-6337
2. Let the pharmacy staff know you want to stop paper printing.
 - Opting in to paperless affects all NGHS retail pharmacies.
3. All future NGHS retail medication references will be available for viewing in MyChart.
 - If needed, paper medication references can be printed on demand.

How to View Medication Information in MyChart

1. Log in to MyChart (Mobile app or Web).
2. For the desktop (web) version of MyChart, click the Medication section, find the medication you want information about, and click the “View medication references” link.*
3. For the mobile MyChart app, tap the medications section, find the medication, tap “show details,” then tap “View medication references” link.*
