 - Family Promise is a national organization with over 41 affiliates and 160,000 volunteers that recognizes this need and works through a variety of programs to see every family in America safely in a home and capable of working toward a brighter future. While they do meet the immediate need for shelter, their focus is on providing a program that works with families to secure steady employment and to find affordable housing. Their guests receive personal emotional counseling, credit counseling, and children's counseling to begin making strides toward identifying the patterns that contribute to their homeless situation. Everything Family Promise does is financed through donations, grants, and fund-raising events. To be eligible for the program, participants must meet the following criteria: Must have children, Must be able and willing to find work, cannot have any domestic violence involved in their situation, must have lived in Hall County for at least 30 days, and must be willing to comply with their Guest Contract and Guidelines.
