- PAN Foundation is an independent, national 501©(3) organization dedicated to helping federally and commercially insured people living with life-threatening, chronic, and rare diseases with the out-of-pocket costs for their prescribed medications
 - Patients must meet the following **criteria** to be eligible for PAN assistance
 - Patient must be getting treatment for the disease named in the assistance program to which he or she is applying
 - Patient must have health insurance that covers his or her qualifying medication or product
 - Patient's medication or product must be listed on PAN's list of covered medications
 - Patient's income must fall at or below 400% or 500% of the Federal Poverty Level depending on fund-specific guidelines
 - Patient must reside and receive treatment in the United States or U.S. territories. (U.S. citizenship is not a requirement)
